St. Francis was one of the pivotal visionary saints of Christianity, calling the Church to its original evangelical richness. Assisi continues to evoke the time and events of St. Francis's life with its preserved medieval town center, soft pink stone structures, and panoramic views of the Umbrian countryside. We will be in Assisi for his feast day and have enough time in Assisi to immerse ourselves in its history, spirituality, art and food. We begin and end our program in Rome, exploring early Christian sites, visiting some of the great monuments of the city, and learning more about the traditions and institutions St. Francis challenged. Throughout the program we will enjoy the warm hospitality of the Italians, benefit from the expertise of local guides, savor Italian cuisine, and be inspired by spiritual leadership of our pastor. Join us for this transformative and memorable journey!

Program Highlights

Fri Sep 28: We Embark on a Pilgrimage in the Footsteps of Visionary Men and Women of Faith. Depart Charlotte for Rome.

Sat Sep 29: Ancient Rome and the Rise of Christianity. Arrival in Rome. Meet the tour manager at the airport and transfer to the hotel. Check into the hotel with some time to freshen up. Go on an afternoon casual walking orientation to Capitoline Hill, the Forum and the Colosseum. Enjoy a welcome dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight Rome.

Sun Sep 30: The Witness of Peter and Early Christians. Breakfast. Begin with a morning guided walking tour of the historic center (with private mass at the Anglican Center in the Palazzo Pamphili). Sites will include the Pantheon, Piazza Navona, Santa Maria Sopra Minerva, and others. Continue to St Peter's for the noon Papal blessing, followed by a light lunch in the area. After lunch, enjoy a guided visit to St. Peter's Basilica and learn about the Circus of Nero that was here, the fire of 64 AD, Nero's persecution and martyrdom of Christians (including

Peter) and then Constantine's building of the basilica, the replacement of the Basilica in the 16th century (during the time of the Reformation). Overnight Rome.

Mon Oct 1: We Journey to Assisi to Explore Evangelical Poverty and Reform of the Church. Breakfast. Travel to Assisi. On arrival, visit the Convento di San Damiano – where St. Francis' story and conversion begins - with either liturgy or prayer here. Continue to the hotel for check-in and a light lunch. This afternoon, enjoy a guided visit of the Basilica of San Francesco> Dinner and overnight Assisi.

Tue Oct 2: Our Spiritual Paths. Breakfast. Begin with a guided visit to Santa Chiara and other historical sites associated with St. Clare and St. Francis in the city center. Have liturgy at St. Leonard's, followed by the afternoon at leisure. Gather for prayer this evening at the hotel. Dinner and overnight Assisi.

Wed Oct 3: *Solitude*. Breakfast. Travel to the Eremo delle Carceri. At the hermitage, attend public or have private liturgy or prayer. The afternoon will be at leisure

for hiking, prayer, wandering, etc.
Depending on interest, visit the ceramics
town of Deruta and one of the workshops
or galleries here. This evening, enjoy a wine
tasting and dinner at a nearby vineyard.
Overnight Assisi.

Thu Oct 4: Celebrating the Visionary Work and Message of St. Francis. Breakfast. Attend a special liturgy today to celebrate St. Francis' feast. Visit the Porziuncula – the small chapel inside the large church in the valley city (Santa Maria degli Angeli). There may be other special events in Assisincluding concerts, liturgies, processions, etc. The afternoon will be free to participate in these. Dinner and overnight Assisi.

Fri Oct 5: Taking the Message of St. Francis to the Larger Church Community.

Breakfast. Travel to Rome. Visit St. John Lateran as the place where St. Francis met the Pope to gain approval for the Order.

Continue with a visit to St. Paul's Outside the Walls, followed by a farewell dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight Rome.

Sat Oct 6: We Return Home as Pilgrims Renewed. Breakfast. Transfer to the airport for the return flight to the USA.
