# CELTIC SPIRITUALITY AND EARLY CHRISTIANITY IN IRELAND

The Rev. Andy Gans invites you to join him in Ireland for an inspiring journey into the Celtic roots of Christianity and the influence of this history on our own Presbyterian heritage. We will have an opportunity to visit sites of great historical and religious significance, learning more about the evangelization of Ireland and the institutions and practices that arose there. Ireland is a land of immense natural beauty. We have created a unique itinerary that weaves together visits to magnificent coastlines, ancient monastic sites, and medieval town centers. Local expert guides will help us make sense of both ancient and contemporary events – including efforts to foster peace and social justice between Catholics and Protestants in Northern Ireland. Throughout our program, we will be treated to Irish culture, food, storytelling and music. Our program includes visits to Dublin, Armagh, Londonderry/Derry, Giant's Causeway and the nearby Corymeela Center, Belfast and nearby Downpatrick, traditional burial site of St. Patrick. Come join us for this rich program!

# Program Highlights

Fri Sep 28: Depart Houston for Dublin.

**Sat Sep 29**: Arrival Dublin. Meet the tour manager and transfer to the hotel in the city center. This afternoon, enjoy a walking orientation of the city center. Go on a guided visit to Trinity College and see the Book of Kells. Have a welcome dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight Dublin.

Sun Sep 30: Breakfast. This morning, visit Monasterboice to see the high crosses and learn about early Christian monastic settlements and Celtic spirituality. Have a possible liturgy here or at a nearby church. Stop briefly at the Hill of Slane to learn about the legendary story of St. Patrick challenging the Druids here. Continue to Kells, where there is a round tower and several crosses in the ruins of the monastery that produced the Book of Kells. Depending on time or interest, visit nearby Loughcrew Cairns to see Neolithic passage graves, and several Castlekeeran to see some high crosses. Return to Dublin for the evening at leisure. Overnight Dublin.

Mon Oct 1: Breakfast. Travel to Armagh. Enjoy an afternoon walking tour of the town center, the two Cathedrals, and St. Patrick's Fold. Learn about the pre-Christian importance of this site and its later development as a center of Christian learning. Overnight Armagh.

Tues Oct 2: Breakfast. Travel to Londonderry/Derry. Stop first at the Navan Center and Fort, just outside of Armagh. This is an interesting Bronze Age site with a visitor center that explores much of the Celtic and Pre-Christian world. After arrival in Londonderry/Derry, go on a walking tour of the walled city section, as well as the Bloody Sunday monument - with an explanation of the history of this day. Enjoy dinner this evening at a restaurant or the hotel. Overnight Londonderry/Derry.

**Wed Oct 3:** Breakfast. Go on a scenic drive along the coast to see the Giant's Causeway and to visit the Corrymeela Center. Continue to Belfast for overnight.

**Thu Oct 4:** Breakfast. Begin with a guided visit to Donegall Square, City Hall, Church

House (the head of the Presbyterian Church of Ireland), and St. Anne's Cathedral. Continue with visits that focus on Christians and Protestants, and the history of the Troubles, ceasefires, and the peace process. This afternoon, meet with the director and members of the Forthspring peace group, established as an interfaith community in 1996. Enjoy dinner this evening at a local pub with music. Overnight Belfast.

Fri Oct 5: Breakfast. Travel to Downpatrick and visit the Cathedral (the legendary burial place for St. Patrick, St. Colmcille, and St. Brigid). Depending on time or interest, take some free time to explore and get lunch independently. Continue with a visit to Saul – and the Church dedicated to St. Patrick's landing here, perhaps with liturgy. Afterwards, visit Struell Wells, a popular pilgrimage destination from the 1600s. Return to Belfast for a festive farewell dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight Belfast.

**Sat Oct 6:** Breakfast. Transfer to the airport for the return flight to Houston.
