Father Gregory Kandt of the Church of the Incarnation in Charlottesville, invites you to join him for a retreat in Assisi - to spend time learning about the life, times and ministry of St. Francis and St. Clare of Assisi. Assisi is one of the best preserved historic cities in Italy where narrow streets, beautiful vistas, and historic buildings evoke another time and invite us to contemplation and reflection. Our time in Assisi includes guided visits and scheduled liturgies - but we have also set aside time so that it is a retreat with leisure to explore at your own pace. In addition to our time in Assisi, we will visit the beautiful medieval town of Siena to explore the life and times of St. Catherine. We will spend time in Rome at the beginning and end of our retreat, including an opportunity to attend the weekly audience with Pope Francis on our last day. Come join us and treat yourself to a memorable and transformative spiritual journey.

Program Highlights

Wednesday, April 11: Depart Washington, D.C. Dulles for Rome.

Thursday, April 12: We Arrive as Pilgrims in Rome.

Arrival Rome. We will meet our tour manager at the airport and transfer by private motorcoach to the guesthouse in the center of Rome. We will have a welcome liturgy at Santa Maria Sopra Minerva at the tomb of St. Catherine to begin the retreat. Afterwards, we will go on an informal walking tour of the historical center, followed by a welcome dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight Rome.

Friday, April 13: The Witness of St. Peter.

Breakfast. Our day will begin with Mass at St. Peter's Basilica, followed by guided visit to the Basilica. We will proceed after to Siena and visit the House of St. Catherine and San Domenico upon arrival. There will be some free time late this afternoon before dinner. Overnight Siena.

Saturday, April 14: St. Francis Called to Rebuild the Church.

Breakfast. If time or interest permits, we will visit the Cathedral in Siena before traveling to Assisi. On the bus ride, we will learn about St. Francis of Assisi's life journey and his rebuilding of San Damiano. We will visit the Convento di San Damiano upon arrival, with liturgy. Afterwards, we will check into the guesthouse with some free time before dinner. Overnight Assisi.

Sunday, April 15: The Evangelical Simplicity of St. Clare.

Breakfast. We will begin with Mass at Santa Chiara, followed by a guided visit to the Basilica of San Francesco. The rest of the day will be devoted to quiet and personal exploration and retreat. We will gather for evening prayer and reflection before dinner. Overnight Assisi.

Monday, April 16: The Visionary Life and Work of St. Francis.

Breakfast. This morning we will transfer to Eremo dei Carceri, with extended time at the Eremo. We will celebrate Mass here (if possible, otherwise at San Ruffino).

On the way back to Assisi, we will visit the Porziuncula in Santa Maria degli Angeli. The afternoon will be devoted to retreat. We will gather again this evening for prayer and reflection before dinner. Overnight Assisi.

Tuesday, April 17: The Stigmata of St. Francis.

Breakfast. Today we will travel to La Verna, with a guided visit to the monastery and Mass. We will proceed to Rome for dinner and overnight.

Wednesday, April 18: The Ministry of the Bishop of Rome.

Breakfast. We will attend the Papal Audience this morning. The afternoon will be free, with help from the tour manager in arranging optional individual visits, if desired. We will gather for liturgy at St. John Lateran, where Francis met the Pope. This evening we will enjoy a farewell dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight Rome.

Thursday, April 19: We Return as Pilgrims Renewed.

Breakfast. We will transfer to the airport for our return to the USA.
