The Most Reverend Robert Coerver, Bishop of the Diocese of Lubbock and Reverend Don Zeiler, pastor of St. Gabriel the Archangel parish in McKinney, invite you to join them for an inspiring pilgrimage to the Holy Land. The Holy Land is often referred to as the 5th Gospel, a place where the people, places and events of the Bible come to life. We will be traveling during a beautiful time of the year in the Holy Land when crowds are thinner and access to sites much nicer. Our program balances archaeological visits, religious visits and opportunities to learn more about the rich cultural life of local people – enjoying their hospitality, food and art. We will celebrate Mass each day at sites where Jesus and his early disciples gathered and/or where pilgrims have gathered over the centuries. Our program also includes a visit to the spectacular site of Petra, in Jordan. This is an enchanting place where monuments are carved into the orange rock and sandstone. En route, we will visit Mt. Nebo where Moses looked out over the Promised Land. Come join us for a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to walk in the footsteps of visionary men and women of faith and connect with your faith heritage.

Program Highlights

Mon Jan 15: We depart DFW for Tel Aviv.

Tue Jan 16: We arrive in Tel Aviv, meet our tour manager and transfer to our hotel in Tiberias. This evening we will have a welcome dinner and opening prayer. Overnight Tiberias.

Wed Jan 17: Breakfast. We travel to Nazareth, stopping en route at Valley of the Doves. We will visit the Basilica of the Annunciation with Mass at the Grotto altar. We continue with a visit to the excavations under the Sisters of Nazareth – a 1st century house that "could" be the house of Mary and Joseph. We then travel to Cana for a visit and a renewal of marriage vows. Before we return to our hotel, we will stop at Mt. Tabor. Dinner/overnight Tiberias.

Thu Jan 18: Breakfast. We begin the day with a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee from the hotel to Capernaum. We then visit the archaeological site of Capernaum and continue to Tabgha (site of multiplication of loaves and fishes). We will celebrate Mass at Tabgha or at Mt. of Beatitudes. We will have lunch at the Mt. of Beatitudes

guesthouse. We will renew our baptism vows at Yardenit. Then we will visit the new archaeological site of Magdal, where there is a 1st century synagogue (likely Jesus would have visited) and the town where Mary Magdalene was from. Dinner/overnight Tiberias.

Fri Jan 19: Breakfast. Today we travel to Petra. We will stop at Madaba and Mt. Nebo (with Mass). Dinner/overnight Petra.

Sat Jan 20: Breakfast. Today we enjoy a full-day visit to Petra. Lunch is included. Late this afternoon, we travel to Eilat and celebrate Mass. Dinner/overnight Eilat.

Sun Jan 21: Breakfast. We journey from Eilat to the Dead Sea to visit Masada. We continue to Jerusalem for dinner/ overnight.

Mon Jan 22: Breakfast. We visit the Western Wall, the temple mount area and the Jerusalem Archaeological Complex and Davidson Center. A light lunch is included. Then we visit the Mount of Olives, with Mass at Dominus Flevit and St. Peter in Gallicantu and the Upper Room. Dinner/overnight Jerusalem.

Tue Jan 23: Breakfast. Today we walk in the footsteps of Jesus - with a devotional walking of the Stations of the Cross ending at the Holy Sepulchre with Mass. The afternoon will be free for people to explore and enjoy the Old City. Dinner/overnight Jerusalem.

Wed Jan 24: Breakfast. We will visit Bethlehem and the Basilica of the Nativity and Shepherd's Field. Lunch is included. We will visit a local Palestinian Christian organization to learn more about the local Christian population. We return to the Old City for some free time. Dinner/overnight Jerusalem

Thu Jan 25: Breakfast. Morning free in the Old City. Afternoon visit Ein Karem (birthplace of John the Baptist) and/or Abu Gosh (Emmaus) – with Mass. Farewell dinner at a restaurant in the area before late evening transfer to airport for return to USA.

Fri Jan 26: Arrival today at DFW.
