Exploring Our Faith Heritage: A Pilgrimage to the Holy Land October 17-27, 2017

You are invited to join a pilgrimage to the Holy Land with Father Tim Clark, pastor of Our Lady of the Lake parish in Seattle. The Holy Land is often referred to as the 5th Gospel, a place where the people, places and events of the Bible come to life. We will be traveling during a beautiful time of the year in the Holy Land, just after the Jewish holidays and at a time when the harvest is rich and people are in a festive mood. Our program balances archaeological visits, religious visits and opportunities to learn more about the rich cultural life of local people – enjoying their hospitality, food and art. We will celebrate Mass each day at sites where Jesus and his early disciples gathered and/or where pilgrims have gathered over the centuries. We will be staying in nice 4-star hotels in locations that give us access to the amenities of Israel during our free time. We have some special meals – even a wine-tasting – built into the program in addition to delicious buffet breakfast and dinner each day. This is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to walk in the footsteps of Jesus along the shores of Galilee and through the historical streets of Jerusalem. Father Tim will share with us his own knowledge of the Holy Land and help us connect with the events and stories of the Gospels. Come join us!

Program Highlights

Tue. Oct. 17: Departure from Seattle for Tel Aviv.

Wed. Oct 18: We Travel as Pilgrims to the Birthplace of Our Faith Tradition. Arrival Tel Aviv. We will travel to Tiberias. If time permits, we stop en route at Mt. Carmel or Megiddo for a visit. Dinner and overnight Tiberias.

Thu. Oct 19: The Roman and Jewish Context of Jesus' Early Life. Breakfast. This morning we travel to Nazareth to visit the Basilica of the Annunciation with Mass at the Grotto. We will visit Mary's well, the synagogue church and the excavations under the Sisters of Nazareth guesthouse. Later we visit Sepphoris, followed by Cana to renew marriage vows. Dinner/overnight Tiberias.

Fri. Oct 20: Jesus' Ministry on the Shores of Galilee. Breakfast. This morning we travel by boat to Capernaum to visit this great archaeological site. We continue to Tabgha to visit to the site of the Multiplication of the Loaves and Fishes, with Mass here. Lunch is included at Peter's Fish Lunch and then we continue with a visit the Mt. of Beatitudes. On return to Tiberias, we visit Nof Ginosar and Magdala. Dinner and overnight Tiberias.

Sat. Oct 21: We Journey with Jesus to Jerusalem. Breakfast. This morning we visit the Mt. of Transfiguration (with Mass) and then Qasr Al-Yahud (near Jericho) for renewal of Baptism. Continue to Mt. of Olives for a panoramic view of the Old City of Jerusalem. We check into the hotel. Some free time this evening to explore the Old City. Dinner and overnight Jerusalem.

Sun. Oct 22: Our Jewish Heritage. Breakfast. This morning we celebrate Eucharist at the Abbey of Dormition. Later we visit the Western Wall, the Temple Mount (Haram Es-Sharif), and the Jerusalem Archaeological Complex and Davidson Center. Enjoy free time in the Old City before visiting a vineyard this afternoon for a wine tasting. Dinner and overnight Jerusalem.

Mon. Oct 23: The Passion of Christ. Breakfast. This morning we visit the Upper Room, St. Peter in Gallicantu, and then the Garden of Gethsemane (with Mass). Lunch will be included today. We continue with the Stations of the Cross - from St. Ann's to the Holy Sepulchre. Dinner and overnight Jerusalem.

Tue. Oct 24: Witnessing to Christ. Early morning Mass at the Holy Sepulchre, followed by breakfast. We travel to Bethlehem to visit the Church of the Nativity and Shepherd's field. We will either visit Herodian (Herod's tomb) or organize a visit with a Palestinian Christian group to learn about their lives, hopes, and struggles. Lunch will be included in Bethlehem. Return to Jerusalem with some free time. Dinner and overnight Jerusalem.

Wed. Oct 25: The Dead Sea. Day excursion to Masada, Qumran and Ein Gedi. Return to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

Thu. Oct 26: We Travel Forth as Pilgrims Renewed. Breakfast. This morning we visit the Israel Museum and Yad Vashem. Afterwards, we visit Ein Karem and Caesarea Maritima. We will enjoy a festive farewell dinner in the area. Transfer late this evening to the airport for return flight to Seattle.

Fri. Oct 27: Arrival back in Seattle today.

\$3675 per person based on double occupancy

\$725 additional - airline taxes, airport fees, security fees, fuel surcharges (estimate as of January 10, 2017)

\$800 supplement for single room occupancy

Please note: Single rooms for single use are limited to 10% of the total number of rooms reserved. Should additional single rooms be requested, hotels may impose a higher supplement for all single rooms of \$1250. Alternatively, if you have selected double occupancy but no roommate is available due to uneven numbers or if your roommate should cancel you will be in a single room and responsible for the single room supplement.
